a. General Engineering

This program provides a broad foundation in engineering by integrating fundamental principles and technologies across multiple fields, including mechanical, electrical, and chemical engineering, with the aim of developing engineering problem-solving skills

b. Global Business

This program aims to develop professionals who can operate effectively in the global market shaped by rapidly changing economic conditions and diverse cultural interactions. It provides a foundation in global business theories and fosters the ability to conduct business successfully across various economic and cultural contexts

c. Marine Biotechnology

This field integrates marine resources with biotechnology to develop professionals who can lead the sustainable marine food industry. It covers marine biology, physiology, and biotechnology, as well as the development of functional food products, providing both scientific knowledge and practical applications for exploring and utilizing the potential of marine resources.

- All documents must be submitted in their original form **in Korean or English**. Documents issued in other languages must be accompanied by a **notarized Korean or English translation**.
- If the original document cannot be submitted, a **certified copy confirmed by the issuing authority or an original notarized copy** must be provided. **Copies of notarized documents will not be accepted.**
- Applicants whose application forms contain errors or omissions, or who fail to submit required documents, will be disqualified at the eligibility screening stage.
- Any applicant found to have submitted false information or fraudulent documents will have their admission revoked, even after enrollment, and tuition will not be refunded.**
- Admission scores will not be disclosed, and **all submitted documents will not be returned.**
- Once the application has been submitted, it cannot be modified or cancelled. **Applicants are responsible for any disadvantages** caused by errors or omissions in the application.
- Admitted applicants must pay tuition within the designated period (installment payments for the first semester are not permitted). Failure to do so will result in cancellation of admission.
